

ENPRO SERVICES OF MAINE, INC. (EMI) AND ENPRO SERVICES OF VERMONT, INC. (EVI) RECEIVE PERMIT RENEWALS, INCLUDING PERMISSION FOR EXPANSION

EMI and EVI offer turnkey hazardous waste Treatment Storage and/or Disposal Facility (TSDF) services throughout the greater Northeast

South Portland, ME and Williston, VT – November 3, 2010 – ENPRO Services, Inc. (ENPRO), a customer-focused firm specializing in the management of oil and hazardous waste, is proud to announce the successful conclusion of the permit renewal processes for ENPRO's associated Treatment, Storage and/or Disposal Facilities (TSDF) in South Portland, Maine and Williston, Vermont. Both facilities have had their respective permits modified and extended, through an extensive process requiring input from and cooperation between the teams at EVI, EMI and ENPRO, as well as the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) and Maine Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

EVI's permit has been modified and renewed for 10 years, as a result of the VT DEC recent acceptance of a Federal Regulations change expanding permit terms from 5 to 10 years. The VT DEC presented EVI's Waste Analysis Plan (WAP), a key operating component of any TSDF permit, to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region One Office for review and comment. EVI is honored by the plan's renewal and by word that the EPA is considering making it a model plan for TSDFs in New England. Furthermore, EVI's request to essentially double its capacity was also approved and incorporated into the new permit. EVI can now store up to the equivalent of 2,000 x 55-gallon containers along with the addition of bulk tank storage for waste oils and non-hazardous liquid.

"These are significant enhancements to EVI as a TSDF; this approval from state and federal regulators has given a well-earned sense of achievement and satisfaction to everyone involved in working on the permit renewal with the VT DEC over the course of the last two plus years," said Jeff Baker, Facility Manager for EVI.

EVI is a RCRA Part B permitted, commercial off-site facility, primarily servicing the New England and New York region. All waste is profiled and characterized for acceptance into the facility, and is stored within a climate-controlled, secure area. All containers of hazardous waste are stored inside a secured warehouse, with a lined secondary containment system. The facility is fully permitted for the management of a wide variety of hazardous and non-hazardous waste materials, including storage, lab-pack consolidation and bulking of liquids and solids and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) waste.

EMI's permit has been modified and renewed for 5 years, as the ME DEP has not adopted the above noted change in Federal Regulations for permit renewals. However, the ME DEP has approved the construction of two enclosed, one hundred cubic yard capacity aboveground cells for the consolidation of oily material and other non-hazardous/special waste. Final design and construction of the building and impermeable concrete cells is targeted for completion in 2011.

"EMI's permit modifications and renewal for 5 years received a unanimous vote of approval by the State of Maine's Board of Environmental Protection, which we feel conveys confidence by the regulators in EMI's operations and management team," said Peter Grenier, Facility Manager for EMI.

EMI operates a fully licensed waste oil, RCRA Part B and Industrial Waste Water treatment facility. The facility specializes in the storage and treatment of waste oil and industrial

wastewater, and has a hazardous waste 10-day transfer station. Its location and accessibility provide customers with an alternative to transporting wastes over long distances to end disposal facilities, thereby realizing cost savings from reducing both transportation costs and man-hours.

Both EVI and EMI have export agreements in place with the USEPA and with Environment Canada for waste transportation to Canadian end disposal facilities.
