## **Oil, hazardous wastes company gets permits to expand**

Nov. 10, 2010 -- ENPRO Services Inc., which manages oil and hazardous wastes says company locations in Maine and Vermont have both received permit renewals and permission to expand.

ENPRO said its treatment, storage and/or disposal facilities in South Portland, Maine, and Williston, Vt., both received permit renewals from state agencies.

ENPRO Services of Vermont Inc. had its "request to essentially double its capacity" approved, the company said. The site can now store up to the equivalent of 2,000 55-gallon containers along with bulk tank storage of waste oils and non-hazardous liquid.

ENPRO Services of Maine Inc., meanwhile, received approval to construct two enclosed, 100-cubic-yard capacity above ground cells for the consolidation of oily material and other non-hazardous/special waste, the company said.
